RIDE WITH US!

The NorCal AIDS Cycle is an annual cycling event born out of a need that continues today. Diminishing resources to support those living with HIV/AIDS lead to a dedicated group of volunteers planning and producing a four-day cycling event to raise funding for AIDS Service Organizations struggling to keep their doors open.

Over the past eighteen years, cyclists and crew from all walks of life and abilities have come together as a community to make a difference, with the money raised benefiting those in the community who need some hope. We're proud to have distributed over \$3 million since our founding.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, our 2022 event will be a two-day ride on May 21 and May 22, 2022. NCAC participants who meet the minimum fundraising levels will also be invited to participate in our Dia De Los Muertos ride on October 29, 2022 with no additional fundraising requirements or registration costs.

2022 ROUTES

On May 21, there are three route options to choose from: 38 miles, 62 miles, and 100 miles.

On May 22, we'll ride 41 miles.

NCAC continues to pursue its mission, even under the difficult circumstances of the COVID19 pandemic. FAQS

How much is registration?

Registration for 2022 is \$50. If you're unable to afford the registration fee, please reach out to us for help.

How much do I need to raise?

For 2022, cyclists are required to raise a minimum of \$1,000 and crew are required to raise a minimum of \$500 to participate. We understand that raising money can be scary. We're with you and we're here to help with tips, advice, and support to help you meet your minimum.

Can I ride my E-Bike?

New for 2022, those with E-Bikes are welcome to join.

What do crew members do?

Crew members are key to the success of our event each year. Jobs include setting up and staffing rest stops, providing medical support (medical requirements apply for these roles), supporting cyclists on the road, and more.

What if I can't participate both days?

You're welcome to join us on the day you're available. The minimum fundraising requirement still applies.
