Tests Prior to Consultation (if available)

Diabetes Mellitus — Type I or Type 2

- Hemoglobin A1C
- TSH, Free T4
- Fasting lipid panel
- Complete metabolic panel (CMP)
- Spot urine microalbumin to urine creatinine ratio
- Finger-stick glucose log or continuous glucose monitor (CGM) report
- Results of 10 gram monofilament testing of feet
- Results of dilated retinal exam

Hypoglycemia in a Patient Without Diabetes Mellitus

- Complete metabolic panel (CMP)
- TSH, Free T4, 8 a.m. serum cortisol level with ACTH level

Thyroid Disorders

- TSH, Free T4
- Free T3, TSH receptor antibody (if hyperthyroid)
- Thyroid ultrasound report/images
- I-123 thyroid uptake and scan reports/images
- CT scan or other imaging reports/images
- Thyroid cancer patients (in addition to above):
 - Thyroglobulin and anti-thyroglobulin antibody levels
 - Surgical pathology report
 - I-131 treatment/whole body scan reports

Pituitary Disorders

- TSH, Free T4
- IGF-1 (Insulin-like Growth Factor -1)
- Prolactin, LH, FSH
- Pituitary MRI reports/images
- Total testosterone (for men) and estradiol (for women)
- 8 a.m. serum cortisol level with ACTH level
- Basic metabolic panel (BMP)

- Total testosterone (for men) and estradiol (for women)

Osteoporosis

- DXA scan report and images
- Complete metabolic panel (CMP)
- 25-hydroxy Vitamin D and Intact PTH levels
- 24-hour urine Calcium and Creatinine collection results

Calcium Disorders

- Basic metabolic panel (BMP)
- Albumin, phosphorus and magnesium levels
- 25-hydroxy Vitamin D and Intact PTH levels
- 24-hour urine Calcium and Creatinine collection results

PCOS

- Complete metabolic panel (CMP)
- Fasting lipid panel
- Hemoglobin A1c
- Total testosterone level
- Anti-mullerian hormone (AMH)
- DHEA-S
- 17-Hydroxyprogesterone level

Information Needed Prior to Scheduling an Appointment

- <u>Telehealth Referral Request Form</u>
- Recent history and physical and all applicable clinical information from patient's chart
- Condition-specific tests as outlined above and on the first page

Information Needed Before the Consultation Begins

- Signed <u>UC Davis Health Acknowledgement of Receipt: Notice of Privacy Practices</u> form (new patients only)
- Documented verbal consent from the patient for participation in a telehealth consultation
- Patient's home finger-stick blood glucose diary/log must be received before consult begins for all diabetes consultations

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
