We offer telehealth consultations for a variety of infectious diseases. If you would like to refer a patient for a condition that is not listed below, please send your request along with the patient's chart notes to the telehealth coordinator for the specialist's consideration.

Clinical Conditions

- HIV Infection (at virtually any stage)
- Viral Hepatitides
- Fungal Infections (cutaneous or systemic)
- Complicated Urinary Tract Infections (UTIs)
- Chronic Osteomyelitis
- Evaluations for Immune Deficiency

Disease-Specific Requirements

Clinical Condition	Tests Prior to Consultation
HIV	HIV Viral Load, CD4 Count
	Prior Antiviral Medications
HCV	HCV Viral Load, Genotype
	Liver Function Tests
	HAV, HBV Serologic Tests

Diagnoses with vague complaints (e.g., chronic fatigue syndrome, fibromyalgia) are more problematic and are usually best evaluated in person. Inappropriate conditions would include those patients too ill to give a history or submit to an examination.

Information Needed Prior to Scheduling an Appointment

- <u>Telehealth Referral Request Form</u>
- Recent history and physical examination, and all applicable clinical information from the patient's chart
- Disease-specific tests as outlined in the section above

Information Needed Before the Consultation Begins

- Signed <u>UC Davis Health Acknowledgement of Receipt: Notice of</u> <u>Privacy Practices</u> form (new patients only)
- Documented verbal consent from the patient for participation in a telehealth consultation

Appointment Scheduling

New: 60 minutes

Follow-up: 30 minutes

Level of Presenter Required at Consultation

May include a brief introduction from the primary care provider when appropriate

Required Equipment

- Videoconferencing Unit
- General Patient Exam Camera



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
