Clinical Conditions

- Esophageal cancer
- Barrett's Esophagus with High Grade Dysplasia (HGD)
- Known or suspected lung cancer
- Pulmonary nodule

Clinical Information (if available prior to consultation)

Clinical Condition	Test/Studies
• Esophageal cancer	Endoscopy report, pathology report, chest CT/IV contrast, PET or PET/CT
Barrett's Esophagus with HGD	Endoscopy report, pathology report, chest CT/IV contrast, PET or PET/CT
Known or suspected lung cancer	Pathology report (if biopsy already performed), chest CT/IV contrast, PET or PET/CT
Pulmonary nodule	Chest CT/IV contrast, PET or PET/CT

Information Needed Prior to Scheduling an Appointment

- Telehealth Referral Request Form
- Necessary Clinical Information (listed in previous section)

Information Needed Before the Consultation Begins

- Signed <u>UC Davis Health Acknowledgement of Receipt: Notice of</u>
 <u>Privacy Practices</u> form (new patients only)
- Documented verbal consent from the patient for participation in a telehealth consultation


