

Preceptorships offer an excellent opportunity for academic and professional growth by providing focused mentoring. Preceptorship open application dates for students not affiliated with a regional nursing school occur three times a year (refer to respective Undergraduate or Graduate Preceptorship Application link). Prior to application submission, it is recommended that applicants secure a UC Davis Medical Center preceptor as placements cannot be guaranteed. Once an application has been submitted, please allow up to **2 months** for full preceptorship clearance. Week 2: UC Davis Medical Center School Liaison receives application

Week 3: Department/School Liaison determines placement request

Week 4: School Liaison emails applicant/school with list of preceptorship clearance requirements

Week 5-6: Applicant/school submits clearance requirements in **ONE** email to: hs-school liaison@ucdavis.edu

Week 7-8: School liaison emails preceptorship clearance to applicant/school contact/APN lead/preceptor
