Preceptorships offer an excellent opportunity for academic and professional growth by providing focused mentoring. Preceptorship open application dates for students not affiliated with a regional nursing school occur three times a year (refer to respective Undergraduate or Graduate Preceptorship Application link). Prior to application submission, it is recommended that applicants secure a UC Davis Medical Center preceptor as placements cannot be guaranteed. Once an application has been submitted, please allow up to **2 months** for full preceptorship clearance.
