

Preceptorships offer an excellent opportunity for academic and professional growth by providing focused mentoring. Preceptorship open application dates for **Advanced Practice Nurse (APN) students not affiliated with a UC Davis program** occur three times a year (refer to Graduate Preceptorship Application link). Once an application has been submitted, please allow up to **2 months** for full preceptorship clearance. Week 1: Applicant/school fills out “Graduate Preceptorship Application” at: <http://www.ucdmc.ucdavis.edu/cppn/studentplacement>

Week 2: UC Davis Medical Center School Liaison receives application

Week 2: School Liaison contacts Advanced Practice Provider (APP) Director for placement availability

Week 3: APP Director contacts requested department to review available providers

Week 4: APP Director contacts School Liaison with preceptor names then School Liaison emails applicant/school with list of preceptorship clearance requirements

Week 5-6: Applicant/school submits clearance requirements in **ONE** email to: hs-schooliaison@ucdavis.edu

Week 7-8: School liaison emails preceptorship clearance to applicant/school contact/APN lead/preceptor
