Mental Health Inequities: Why they Exist and Persist

Join us for a talk with Dr. Ruth Shim that will examine persistent mental health disparities. This presentation will evaluate the factors that led to our present state, new evidence, and novel strategies to reduce and eliminate mental health disparities and inequities.
