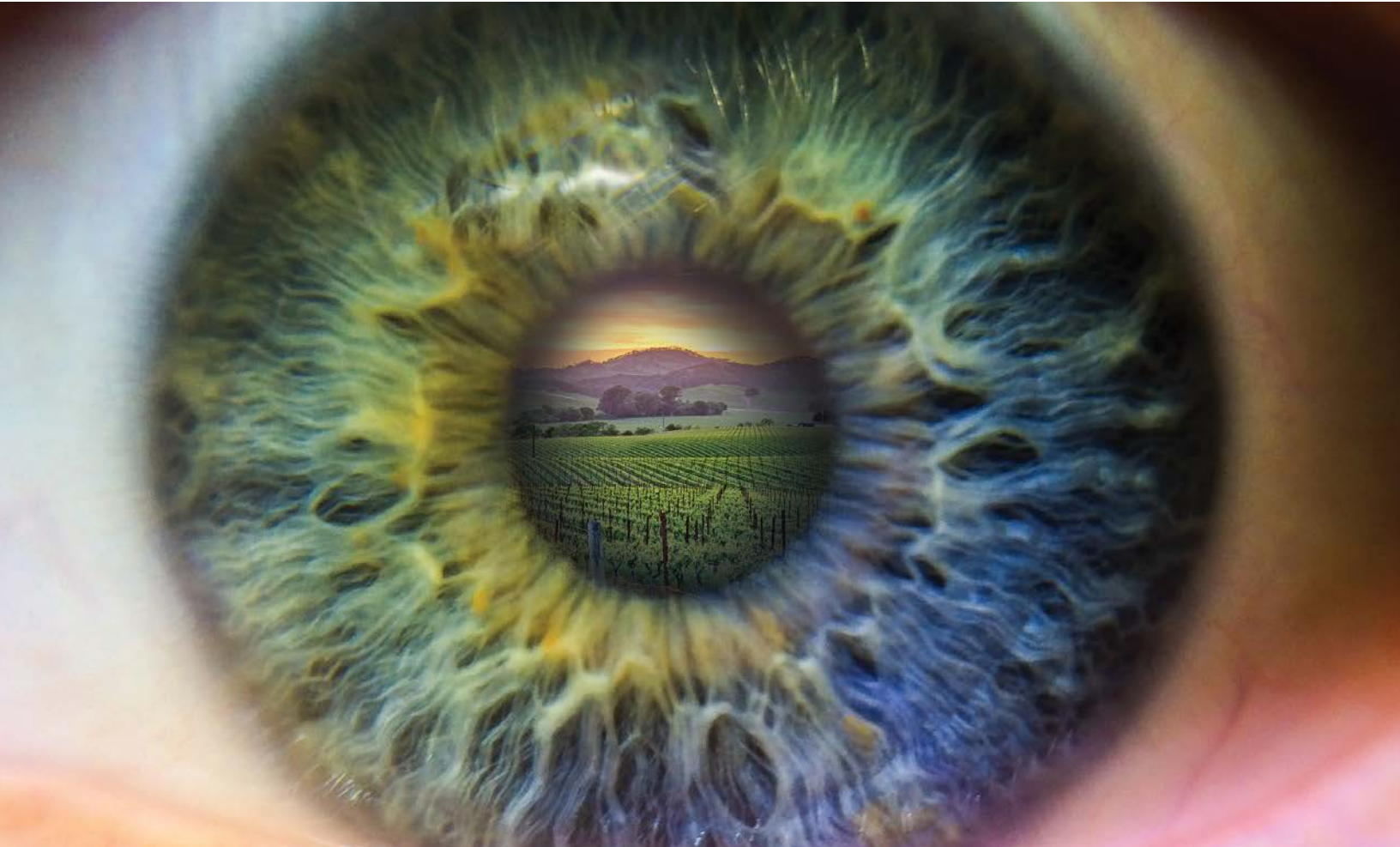
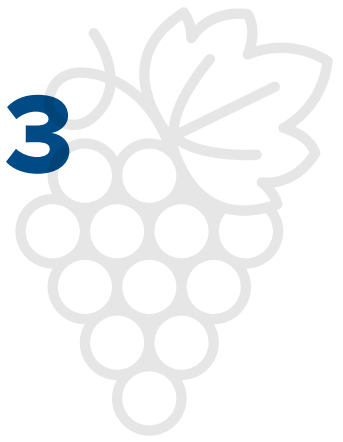

NEEDS ASSESSMENT
