UC Davis Health in Sacramento, California requests Statements of Qualifications **on or before 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 26, 2022**, from qualified firms interested in providing Architectural Consulting Services for the following project:

CAMPUS DESIGN GUIDELINES & STANDARDS

The intent of this effort is to develop a set of campus design guidelines and standards to consistently communicate UC Davis Health's planning and design principles to internal stakeholders, outside agencies, consultants, and contractors. While the Facilities Planning & Development Division currently has some project design guidelines and standards, they are inadequate for the size and scope of the current project portfolio. Therefore, this project will integrate existing guidelines and standards where applicable while filling in the gaps to create a set of cohesive documents.

The selected firm shall be led by an architect team supported by subconsultants which may include urban designers, MEP engineers, structural engineers, landscape architects, etc. Interested firms shall demonstrate collaborative expertise in the design of comparable design document preparation.

Interested firms must demonstrate a history of delivering similar types of initiatives and their ability to engage cross-functional stakeholders in large organizations in collaborative discussions throughout the process. The selected firm will be expected to sign a Professional Services Agreement with the University.

Statements of qualifications shall be specifically tailored to this RFQ, responding directly to the screening criteria (See RFQ document and Consultant Qualification form available on the above link). After Qualification Statements are received, a Screening Committee will review, conduct reference checks, and recommend a short list of firms for interviews. A Selection Committee will conduct the interviews prior to selecting the successful firm.

Statements of qualifications must be submitted electronically no later than **2:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 26, 2022** to the link to be provided by UC Davis Health. No hard copies will be accepted. Firms interested in responding to this RFQ must notify the University by Monday, July 25, 2022 to be provided a link to upload their Qualifications package.

Questions and requests for the link to upload statements may be addressed via email only to Leila Couceiro, FD&C Contracts Manager, at lccouceiro@ucdavis.edu. Statements of Qualifications will not be accepted after the date and time stipulated above.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each firm may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful firm and their subconsultants will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Agreement documents and to pay prevailing wages at the location of the work. The work described in the Agreement is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

Consultant/Design Professional shall pay all persons providing services and/or any labor on site, including any University location, no less than UC Fair Wage (defined as \$15 per hour as of 10/01/2017) and shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local working condition requirements.
