## **OSLER Step 1 Review**

The OSLER Step 1 Review is an 8-week guided study plan that provides students who have deferred Step 1 with increased structure and accountability during the first two months (March/April) of their study period prior to completing an individual Step 1 study plan in May/June.

## Goals of the OSLER Step 1 Review are to:

- Provide students with structure and accountability to support completion of a comprehensive review of Step 1 content prior to beginning an individual dedicated study period.
- Provide opportunities to practice active learning strategies that can be used during independent study.
- Provides opportunities to apply and practice effective test taking strategies while completing practice questions and assessments.
- Provide support related to individual study, learning and test taking needs.

## Requirements

- Participate in Step 1 Review from February 28-April 22, 2022.
- Follow a weekly Step 1 study schedule provided by OSLER
- Complete daily assignments created by OSLER
- Attend all in-person group sessions and individual meetings with OSLER Learning specialists.
