Integrated EXplorative Patient- and Learner-ORiented Education (I-EXPLORE)

The new curriculum, I-EXPLORE, is part of our educational continuous quality improvement (CQI) efforts to pursue and maintain the highest standards in medical education. Here are some exciting updates and upcoming plans:

- School of Medicine Bylaws & Regulations: In February 2021, 95% of faculty voted to approve changes that will enhance faculty involvement and oversight of I-EXPLORE through committee functions.
- I-EXPLORE faculty leadership opportunities: Be on the look out for a call for faculty to apply for the new I-EXPLORE roles. The Committee on Education Policy will review applications and select course leaders, discipline leads, scholarly concentration mentors and problem-based learning facilitators. Newly appointed faculty will work with the Curriculum Implementation Team beginning in April 2021, with I-EXPLORE roll out continuing through the next two years.
- I-EXPLORE Implementation Plan: In the upcoming Academic Year 2021-22, 1st and 3rd year students will start I-EXPLORE. The 2nd and 4th year curriculum will start in Academic Year 2022-23.
- I-EXPLORE Monthly Newsletter: To stay up to date on I-EXPLORE, a monthly newsletter will be distributed beginning in April. In it, readers will learn more about the collaborative and innovative work being done to launch our integrated, three pillar curriculum.
