

MEDICAL STUDENT PARKING OPTIONS

I. Green Commuter Pass (courtesy to medical students)

- ➤ A medical student can register quarterly as a Green Commuter if he/she <u>walks</u> to school during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. Once registered, student will receive a *courtesy* SOM permit to park after 5:00 p.m. 6:00 a.m. Monday Friday and all day on Saturday and Sunday in Lots 12, 14, 16, and 17.
- ➤ A medical student can register quarterly as a Green Commuter if he/she <u>bikes</u> to school during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. Once registered, student will receive a *courtesy* SOM permit to park after 5:00 p.m. 6:00 a.m. Monday Friday and all day on Saturday and Sunday in Lots 12, 14, 16, and 17. The student will also receive 24 courtesy Rideshare permits to use in a fiscal year (July-June) on the days that student drives to medical center campus during peak hours (7:00 am 5:00 pm)

II. Temp C Permit (monthly cost to student)

➤ All medical students are also eligible for a Temp C permit that allows students to park in C Permit lots during the business hours and are allowed to park in B permit lots (Lot 12 and 14) after hours (5:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m.) and weekends (24 hours) for easy access to their vehicles at night from the Education Building. When parking at UC Davis campus during peak hours, Temp C permit parking is allowed only in C lots on campus.

NOTE: If a student, for any reason, is no longer enrolled with the school, he/she should return the SOM permit and the courtesy Rideshare immediately to the Parking Office. These permits are not transferrable as they are registered to the individual Green Commuter registrant.
