

Pulled from Coursework

Students will be, by default, pulled from coursework by CSP, while awaiting a decision by CSP, if eligible for dismissal for the following reasons:

1. Receipt of a 2nd and all subsequent F grades 80(D)(1)(a)i
2. Receipt of a deficiency while on a modified curriculum for academic deficiencies 80(D)(1)(a)iii
3. Failure to pass USMLE step exam within 3 attempts 80(D)(1)(a)iv
4. Failure to pass USMLE step 1 within 1 year of the end of the 2nd year curriculum unless previously approved by CSP 80(D)(1)(a)v

If a student is eligible for a dismissal recommendation solely for receipt of a deficiency while on academic warning or probation (deficiency upon a deficiency), the following factors will be considered and, at the discretion of the Chair of CSP, the student may be allowed to continue in their coursework while awaiting a decision by CSP:

1. Previous Academic History
2. Circumstances

If a student is eligible for a dismissal recommendation for other reasons as outlined in the School of Medicine Bylaws 80(D), the student may be allowed to continue in their coursework while awaiting a decision by CSP at the discretion of the Chair.

When a decision to pull a student from coursework is at the discretion of the Chair, the Chair will have 5 Business Days to notify the student of their decision.
