Introducing the Premier Advantage Option

FAQs

University of California, Davis Medical Center offers the Premier Advantage plan option that gives you the freedom and choice to enroll in either the PPO Plan or the DHMO 500 plan and switch plans on a monthly basis for one cost per month.

What is Premier Advantage?

- Members have the option to enroll on the PPO plan and the DHMO 500 plan option
- Members may switch from plan to plan each month for however many times they choose without any frequency limitations during the policy year
- Gives members the freedom to choose between two plan options that best suits their coverage needs and financial situation

What are some of the added benefits?

- Unlimited Calendar Year Maximum
- Scheduled copayments per procedure that are generally less expensive then the PPO coinsurance
- Child and Adult Orthodontia coverage
- Posterior Composites are covered rather than just Amalgam as on the PPO plan
- No waiting period for members without prior coverage
- Oral Cancer screenings included
- Coverage for Veneers included
- Additional cleanings are available

How can I switch from the PPO plan to the new DHMO plan?

When will my plan change take effect?

• Plan change requests made by the 25th of the month will take effect the 1st of the following month.

Will I have to pay a higher rate to switch plans?

• No, you will pay the same rate per month for both plans.

Can I switch back to the PPO plan if I'm on the DHMO plan?
