

Associate Director for Davis-based Medical Student Research

The UC Davis School of Medicine is ranked nationally as a diverse, primary care, and research institution. Medical students have several options to research including, but not limited to, ARC-M.D., M.D./Ph.D., and general research. Many of these students explore research opportunities in Davis campus. The Associate Director for Davis-based Medical Student Research (ADDMSR) will focus on research activities and undergraduate student outreach.

Terms:

- ADDMSR will serve a three-year term (July 2023 through June 2026) and renewable thereafter
- 20% salary in salary and benefits support

Expectations:

- Coordinate outreach activities for UC Davis undergraduates interested in attending medical school and joining ARC-MD or M.D./Ph.D.
- Identify research opportunities for ARC-MD and M.D./Ph.D. students in Davis-based research labs.
- Work with Davis-based mentors to develop effective mentoring strategies for ARC-MD and M.D./Ph.D. during their research year.
- Monitor research experience of ARC-MD and M.D./Ph.D. students during their research-intensive year.
- Work with other APDs and Directors to ensure cohesiveness and meaningful interactions between Sacramento and Davis-based students in research tracks.
- Plan morale building activities, including social events.

Administration:

- The appointed faculty member will report to the Vice Dean for Basic Sciences and the ARC-MD director with dotted line reporting to M.D./Ph.D. director. Office of Medical Education will provide necessary administrative support.
