1. The Department of HHS has new requirements for Clinical Trials compliance (eff 1/18/2017):

HHS requires registration and results of applicable clinical trials into *clinicaltrials.gov* (FDAAA 801).

Applies to *all* clinical trials funded in whole or in part by NIH, regardless of study phase, type of intervention, or whether they are subject to the Final Rule. Clinical trials that use NIH-supported infrastructure, but receive no other NIH funds for the conduct of a specific clinical trial are not subject to the NIH Policy.

Clinical trial is as "a research study in which one or more human subjects are prospectively assigned to one or more interventions (which may include placebo or other control) to evaluate the effects of those interventions on health-related biomedical or behavioral outcomes."

The Final Rule applies to "responsible parties" for "applicable clinical trials." A responsible party is the sponsor of the clinical trial or a designated principal investigator.

Significant fines of ~\$11,000/day may be levied for noncompliance.

Costs can be included in the budget to cover costs of staff time, and perhaps other items related to data archiving. Some costs will be retrieved through indirect costs. For more information, see:
