

Chancellor Hexter, Interim Chancellor shared the following call on February 7th, 2017:

You can also help representatives from other constituencies understand your interests and concerns and, in turn, learn more about their views of campus issues.

As indicated in our <u>Principles of Community</u>, we aspire to create an inclusive community and therefore committee members are selected based on the interest of applicants coupled with the desire to have each committee reflect multiple dimensions of diversity – for example but not limited to ethnicity, gender, academic discipline, etc. – to inform administrative decision making.
