1. UC DAVIS HEALTH, SMUD, AND SACRAMENTO STATE PARTNER ON NEW CHILDCARE CENTER

UC Davis Health, SMUD, and Sacramento State have joined forces to create a new child development center in Sacramento. Located at 6011 Folsom Boulevard, the facility is scheduled to open in early 2021 and accommodate up to 208 children. This partnership will bring 100 new, quality child-care spaces to Sacramento, doubling the capacity of SMUD's on-campus Lighthouse Child Development Center, which has reached its end of life. All children currently enrolled at the Lighthouse will be guaranteed a space at the new facility. Remaining spaces will be made available to UC Davis, SMUD and Sac State employees. 2. U.S. NEWS AND WORLD REPORT RANKS UC DAVIS MEDICAL CENTER AS THE #1 HOSPITAL IN SACRAMENTO – SACRAMENTO BEE



UC Davis Medical Center maintained its position as Sacramento's best hospital, according to the2019-2020 rankings released Tuesday by U.S. News & World Report, despite big changes in how the magazine's editors evaluated hospital performance. The teaching hospital was the only local institution among the top 10 California medical centers. "This is great news for our patients and for the communities we serve," said David Lubarsky, the chief executive officer of UC Davis Health. "It reflects our many ongoing partnerships with the community to deliver highly

3. SYSTEMWIDE POLICY CHANGES TO APM 278 AND 210-6

UC-wide policy changes have been implemented regarding 1) APM Section 278, Health Sciences Clinical Professor Series, and 2) APM Section 210-6, Instructions to Review Committees Which Advise on Actions Concerning the Health Sciences Clinical Professor Series. The University has also developed guidelines for "Broadened definition of scholarly and creative activity for local UCD implementation of APD 210-d and 278." These changes are as follows:

1) Expanding the HSCP criteria to include "scholarly or creative activity" and "university and public service," in addition to the current teaching and clinical activity requirements; and

2) Expanding the academic advancement evaluation criteria to be defined broadly, taking into account the primary emphasis on clinical teaching and patient care services.
