

1. CHANGES PROPOSED TO INTER CAMPUS SHUTTLE



The UC Davis Intercampus Shuttle has served the UCD employees, faculty, students, volunteers, and patients for over 30 years. This service has become an integral part of hundreds of riders' lives. The best estimates show that some 400+rides occur each day, and the riders have only observed the shuttle getting more popular over the last decade. However, UC Davis is planning to eliminate the intercampus shuttle (effective April 2020) and is directing intercampus commuters to a new Yolobus/SacRT public transit line. The new line will not be managed or controlled by UC Davis. This change will be detrimental to countless riders between both locations and will lead to more cars on the road.

UCD, SacRT, and Yolobus are taking the stance that despite the 500+ signatures on the letter are the work of a few vocal people and not representative of the general ridership. They are asking for individual comments, some due as early as this Tues Nov 12. It is unfortunate they are choosing to ignore the letter, but it does present us with another opportunity to let more decision makers know how riders feel about the cancellation.
