

#### **Overview**


- Originally constructed in late 1920s
- Added on to in the 1950's
- Approximately 188,000 square feet
- 6 stories plus basement



#### **Schedule**

- April 2024 Complete move out accomplished
- May 2024 Start disconnection of utilities
- 2030 Start Demolition

Current seismic mandates via Assembly Bill 2190 requires all occupants and operations to clear the structure by 2024.







Make Ready scope includes **five major phases** including:


- Re-routing existing site utilities





# **48X Surgical Complex**

- Phase 1 Completion in Summer 2025
- 268,000 square feet
- \$589 million
- Program
  - 14 Operating Rooms
  - 2 Procedure Rooms
  - 60 PACU rooms/bays
  - 14 Recovery Rooms
  - 4 Interventional Radiology Rooms
  - 100,000 GSF of clinics
  - Lab
  - Radiology
  - Retail Pharmacy





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
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### Regional Development | Folsom Medical Care Clinic

- 114,000 SF
- Budget: \$170M
- Open Summer 2025

# **Our Shared History**

- It took almost 100 years to reach the current 3.5 M SF.
- Vision 2030 includes an additional 3M SF of development – almost doubling the campus size within 10 years.

#### Number of Helipads


- o 2 on the CA Tower
- Davis Tower will decommission one (except in emergency or maintenance situations).

#### • Why?

- Need for new helidecks
- Slight increase in the number of flights.

#### Construction Phase

 Once cranes are erected, the routes will change for the Davis Tower.



**Project Goal** – "Provide adequate healthcare helicopter landing areas and reduce helicopter idling time by providing increased helipad capacity."

Two new rooftop helipads for air ambulances

One larger to allow for infrequent landing of Sikorsky Firehawk helicopters

Under future conditions:

- Approx. 15 percent to land at the existing Davis Tower
- 85 percent expected to land at the California Hospital Tower.
- Both helipads on the Davis Tower would remain, one for active operations and one backup use during maintenance.



#### **UC Davis Health | Helicopter Noise**

The University of California Board of Regents certified the California Hospital Tower EIR in November 2021, adopting CEQA mitigation NOI-4b.

#### Residential sound reduction program to reduce noise


Provide noise reduction modifications to homes within <u>modeled</u> <u>flightpath noise contours</u>

#### Qualifications:

- Be within the SEL 95dBA noise contour
- SEL 80 dBA inside in sleeping areas with windows closed

#### **Potential Home Modifications:**

- Acoustical windows, doors, insulation, ventilation modifications
- Not to exceed \$35,000 per house



#### **Current Phase:**

Confirming modeled flightpath noise contours and setting up program

#### **Upcoming Notifications:**

- August 2025 Outreach to eligible homes by mail and in-person outreach
- Sign up for Listserv: email environreview@ucdavis.edu and put in subject "RSRP"
- Official website coming summer 2025

- Free indoor air purifier with replacement filters until 2030 for pre-determined homes nearest the construction site
- Collaboration with Breathe California Sacramento Region
- Unit will have a HEPA filter highest indoor filtration level
- A Levoit Vital 200S or similar unit will be provided







- Determined by air dispersion modelling
- Limited to approximately V, U and T
   Street homes near Main Hospital
- Notification coming by letter and doorhangers
- Begin delivery in June 2024
- Enroll today!
- Note: this program remains open during the entire construction phase
