FlagS are symbols of community membership, unity, and visibility. The Pride flags have evolved over the years to promote greater inclusion and recognize our various communities. The flags below are only some of the many used by LGBTQ+ people to show their pride.

## The Pride Flag Through the Ages

Hot pink and turquoise proved difficult to mass produce, so they were removed. The six color rainbow flag was introduced after the assassination of Harvey Milk. it endured for over three decades. bottom this flag represents sex, life, healing, sunlight, nature, magic \& art, serenity, and spirit.



Following the theme of inclusivity, Valentino Vecchietti added the intersex pride symbol and colors to the Progress flag two year ago.
