## What to Do if a Federal Immigration Agent Contacts You

I am a UC Davis employee, what do I do if a federal immigration agent comes to my workspace with a warrant or subpoena?

- 1. Inform the agent that you are not obstructing their process and need to consult with campus counsel because you are not authorized to give consent to access persons or non-public areas of buildings.
- 2. Call Campus Counsel at (530) 754-7111.
- 3. Call UCDH PD at (916) 734-2555 or UCDPD on the main campus at (530) 752-1727.
- 4. Ask for the agent's name, ID number, agency affiliation, and business card.
- 5. Ask to take a photo of the warrant or subpoena so you can provide it to campus counsel.
