

What to Do if a Federal Immigration Agent Contacts You

I am a UC Davis employee, what do I do if a federal immigration agent comes to my workspace with a warrant or subpoena?

1. Inform the agent that you are not obstructing their process and need to consult with campus counsel because you are not authorized to give consent to access persons or non-public areas of buildings.
2. Call Campus Counsel at (530) 754-7111.
3. Call UCDH PD at (916) 734-2555 or UCDPD on the main campus at (530) 752-1727.
4. Ask for the agent's name, ID number, agency affiliation, and business card.
5. Ask to take a photo of the warrant or subpoena so you can provide it to campus counsel.
