

Did you know the following are regulated?

Unopened Alcohol Based Products

Examples include - Hand sanitizing gel, Preventions swabs, SurePrep wipes, Chloraprep and DuraPrep surgical solutions

*Opened/used alcohol products can be disposed in municipal trash (preferred)

(Flamm/Tox Bin)

Surgical Skin Markers

(Flamm/Tox Bin)

Personal Care Products

Examples include – Lotions, shampoo, body wash, lip balm, toothpaste

*Send opened personal care products home with patient (preferred)



BLUE PHARM

Unused/Residual Povidone Iodine

Examples include – Full, containers with residual, or unopened



BLUE PHARM

Unused/Residual Topical Ointment Products

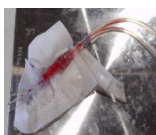
Examples include – Unused petrolatum dressings, tubes/packets that are full or contain residual topical ointment

*Do not place sharps in **Red** biohazardous waste bin
