

Red Bag Transport – All Red in Red

All Red-in-Red: Waste items with blood of any kind in any amount are biohazardous waste

Utilize red transport bags when generating smaller volumes of biohazardous waste, and ensure staff are adequately trained to continue proper segregation.

New, small transport bags are now available and feature adhesive strips to seal and secure waste.

Help Waste Find Its Place

Do not place regulated items in the municipal trash. We must do our part to properly segregate our waste.
