

Red Bag Transport - All Red in Red

All Red-in-Red: Waste items with blood of any kind in any amount are biohazardous waste

Utilize red transport bags when generating smaller volumes of biohazardous waste, and ensure staff are adequately trained to continue proper segregation.

New, small transport bags are now available and feature adhesive strips to seal and secure waste.

Properly bagged waste <u>under</u> 1lb, 3 gallons, or 500 mL can be disposed of inside a:

Red Step-On Container
or
Take to Soiled Utility Room





Properly bagged waste <u>over</u> 1lb, 3 gallons, or 500 mL must be contained at the point of generation

Bring Soiled Utility
Container to the Point of
Generation, as needed
