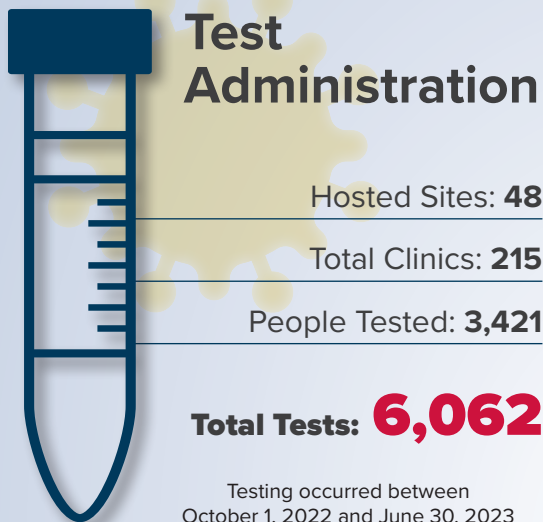
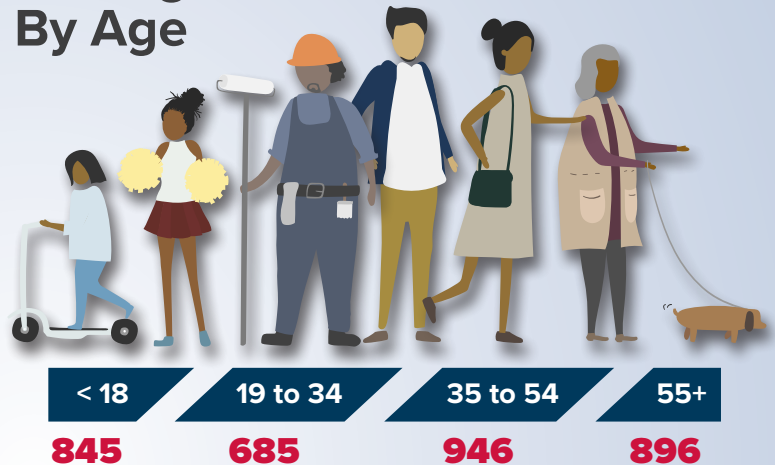

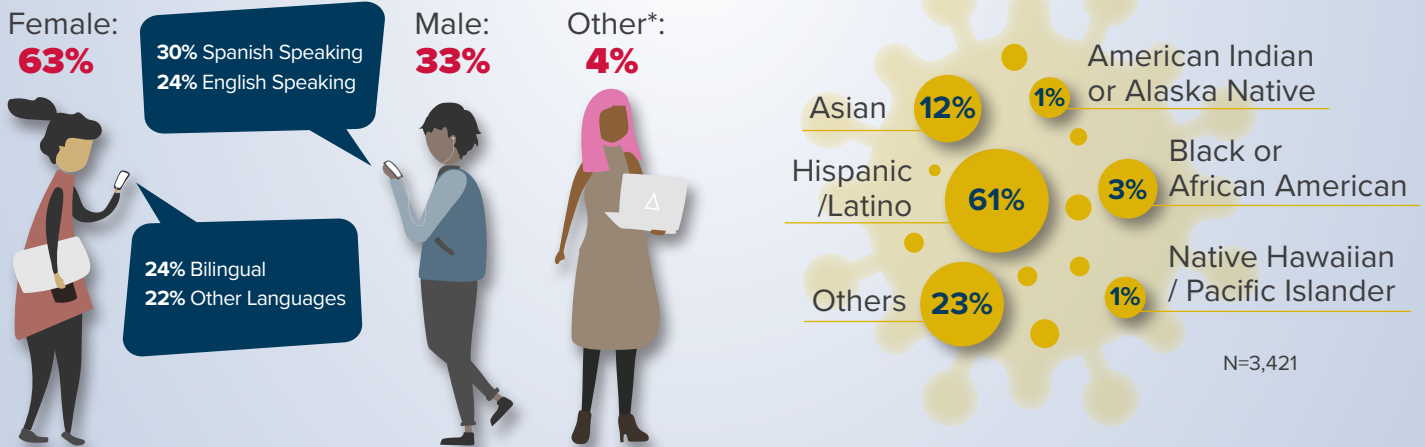

Testing Frequency



Reported Symptoms for Positive Cases

Total Positive Tests: **38**

Positive Test Rate: **0.63%**

- Abdominal Pain: 1 person
- Headache: 1 person
- Loss of Taste or Smell: 4 people
- Cough: 6 people
- Body Aches: 2 people
- Nausea: 4 people
- Difficulty Breathing: 7 people

“I had contact with a doctor through a tablet, we had contact to give me medication for COVID. It is good that you are there at the clinic. They are free. What else can one ask for in life.”

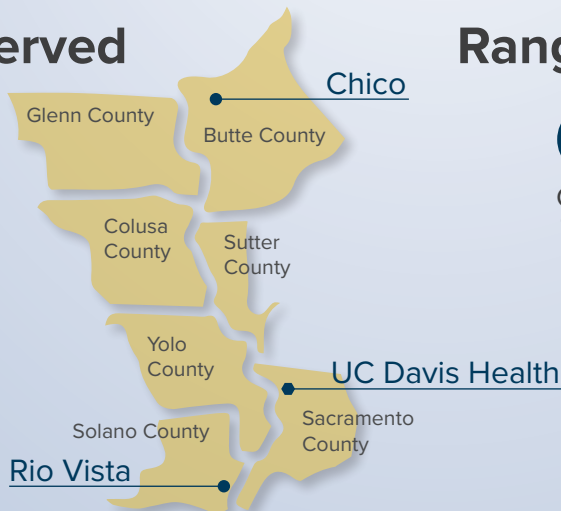
