This medical equipment change out will include flooring, ceiling, casework & finishes upgrade. Accessibility upgrades will take place for toilets, dressing rooms and drinking fountain.

Only prequalified contractors who participate in the pre-bid conference and job walk, in its entirety, will be allowed to bid on the project. Participants must arrive at or before 4:30 p.m. Contractor representatives arriving later than 4:30 p.m. will not be allowed to submit bids as prime trade contractor on the project. Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Proposal, excluding alternates, shall accompany each bid. The surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the bid deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120)

All insurance policies required to be obtained by the successful bidder shall be subject to approval by University for form and substance. All such policies shall be issued by a company rated by Best as A- or better with a financial classification of VIII or better, or have equivalent rating by Standard and Poor's or Moody's.

The successful bidder will be required to have the following California contractor's license at the time of the bid opening: "B" – General Building.

Estimated Construction Cost: \$1,771,100.00

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy.
