

ANNOUNCEMENT TO PREQUALIFIED BIDDERS

Subject to conditions prescribed by the University of California, UC Davis Health, sealed bids for a lump-sum contract are invited from prequalified bidders for the following work:

**PROJECT NO. 9558910
DAVIS TOWER #0711 & 0762 PHARMACY REMODEL**

Description of Work: Project is the renovation of the Pharmacy Department at the basement level approximately 470,996SF, including the addition of new support spaces. Work will be carried out in sequences to ensure uninterrupted pharmacy operations, with temporary equipment relocation utilizing existing storage #0761. The scope also includes the remodel of multiuser toilet rooms #0786 and #0784 to address accessibility deficiencies and ensure compliance with current code. Project consists of the demolition of existing spaces within the basement pharmacy (except for Central Pharmacy #0762) and a remodel that includes the receiving area, non-sterile compounding room, hazardous drug storage room, staff lounge, and offices. The scope does not include sterile compounding rooms (under USP797/800).

Prequalified Bidders must attend a **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference and job walk at **2 p.m., Monday, October 20, 2025**. Only prequalified contractors who participate in the pre-bid conference and job walk, in its entirety, will be allowed to bid on the project. Participants must arrive at or before 2 p.m.. Contractor representatives arriving later than 2 p.m. will not be allowed to submit bids as prime trade contractor on the project. Participants shall meet at the Facilities Planning & Development office (4800 2nd Avenue, Suite 3010, Sacramento, CA 95817).

The lowest responsible bidder will be selected on the basis of the best value to the University. The objective criteria and methodology used to determine Best Value are described in the Bidding Documents. The best value to the University is the selection resulting in the best combination of price and qualifications.

Sealed Bids and Bid Bonds must be received on or before 2 p.m., Thursday, November 20, 2025, at Facilities Planning & Development, 4800 2nd Avenue, Suite 3010, Sacramento, CA 95817. Please have your **Best Value Questionnaires provided separately and submitted on or before 2 p.m., Friday, November 21, 2025, in pdf format to an upload link that will be provided by the University** to prequalified bidders who attend the entire Prebid Conference and Job Walk. Bids will be opened at a later date, after questionnaires evaluation is completed by the University. Target date for public bid opening is **Thursday, December 4, 2025, 10 a.m.** at the same address above. If the evaluation takes longer than anticipated, we will issue an addendum changing the public bid opening date.

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Proposal, excluding alternates, shall accompany each bid. The surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the bid deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120)

The successful bidder will be required to have the following California contractor's license at the time of the bid opening:
"B" – General Building.

Estimated Construction Cost: **\$4,435,521.00**

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wages at the location of the work.

In addition, the University is committed to promoting and increasing participation of small business enterprises (SBEs) and disabled veteran business enterprises (DVBES) relating to all goods and services covered under the awarded agreement, subject to any and all applicable obligations under state and federal law, and University policies. No contractor or subcontractor, regardless of tier, may be listed on a Bid for, or engage in the performance of, any portion of this project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 and 1771.1.
