Subject to conditions prescribed by the University of California, UC Davis Health, sealed bids for a lump-sum contract are invited from prequalified bidders for the following work:

EDUCATION BUILDING IT NETWORK MODERNIZATION**

Description of Work: This project is an infrastructure upgrade in the Education Center Building. Work to existing telecom rooms will upgrade electrical, IT, and mechanical systems. This includes but is not limited to relocating existing equipment racks, adding new racks, new UPS, new WAPs & cabling, receptacles, light fixtures, mini power zones, and power distribution units. New HVAC system installation and associated piping, as well as ceiling demolition are also included as part of this project. Work does not impact existing fire separation walls.

Prequalified Bidders must attend a **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference and job walk at **9 a.m. Monday, July 8, 2024**. Only prequalified contractors who participate in the pre-bid conference and job walk, in its entirety, will be allowed to bid on the project. Participants must arrive at or before 9 a.m. Contractor representatives arriving later than 9 a.m. will not be allowed to submit bids as prime trade contractor on the project. Participants shall meet at the Facilities Planning & Development office (4800 2nd Avenue, Suite 3010, Sacramento, CA 95817).

The lowest responsible bidder will be selected on the basis of the best value to the University. The objective criteria and methodology used to determine Best Value are described in the Bidding Documents. The best value to the University is the selection resulting in the best combination of price and qualifications.

Sealed Bids and Bid Bonds must be received on or before 2 p.m. Thursday, July 25, 2024, at Facilities Planning & Development, 4800 2nd Avenue, Suite 3010, Sacramento, CA 95817. Please have your **Best Value Questionnaires provided separately and submitted on or before 2 p.m. Friday, July 26, 2024, in pdf format to an upload link that will be provided by the University** to prequalified bidders who attend the entire Prebid Conference and Job Walk. Bids will be opened at a later date, after questionnaires evaluation is completed by the University. Target date for public bid opening is Thursday, August 1, 2024, 2:00 p.m. at the same address above. If the evaluation takes longer than anticipated, we will issue an addendum changing the public bid opening date.

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Proposal, excluding alternates, shall accompany each bid. The surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the bid deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120)

The successful bidder will be required to have the following California contractor's license at the time of the bid opening: "B" – General Building.

Estimated Construction Cost: \$2,500,000.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful Bidder and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wages at the location of the work.

In addition, the University is committed to promoting and increasing participation of small business enterprises (SBEs) and disabled veteran business enterprises (DVBES) relating to all goods and services covered under the awarded agreement, subject to any and all applicable obligations under state and federal law, and University policies. No contractor or subcontractor, regardless of tier, may be listed on a Bid for, or engage in the performance of, any portion of this project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 and 1771.1.
