

MATERIALS TESTING & INSPECTION AND GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES PROJECT 9565150, PARKING STRUCTURE 7

UC Davis Health in Sacramento, California requests Statements of Qualifications on or before <u>2 p.m.</u> <u>Tuesday, April 9, 2024</u>, from qualified firms interested in providing Materials Testing and Inspection and Geotechnical services for the Parking Structure 7 project.

The nature of the services requested and the duration of the project require a contract of approximately 15 months through July 2025. The University expects the proposer to adequately staff the Project with fully qualified materials testing and inspection staff as the job demands.

The Special Inspector shall perform its services in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, applicable codes, regulations, and accepted testing procedures, and shall furnish all material, labor, equipment, and tools. All special inspectors shall perform all services provided in accordance with the Contract Documents, Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations (as amended), and all applicable State and local codes and regulations.

Qualification documents with additional information, selection criteria, and scope description for interested firms will be available starting Friday, March 15, 2024, and can be downloaded directly from our website at: https://health.ucdavis.edu/facilities/work-with-us/consultants/rfq

Statements of qualifications shall be specifically tailored to this RFQ, responding directly to the screening criteria (See RFQ document and Consultant Qualification form available on the above link). After Qualification Statements are received, a Screening Committee will review, conduct reference checks, and recommend a short list of firms for interviews. A Selection Committee will conduct discussions with the shortlisted firms prior to selecting the consultant for this project.

Statements of qualifications must be submitted electronically no later than <u>2 p.m. Tuesday</u>, <u>April 9</u>, <u>2024</u> to the link to be provided by UC Davis Health. No hard copies will be accepted. Firms interested in responding to this RFQ must notify the University Monday, April 8, 2024, to be provided a link to upload their Qualifications package.

Questions and requests for the link to upload statements may be addressed via email only to Hans Ram, Contracts Administrator, at hlram@ucdavis.edu. Statements of Qualifications will not be accepted after the date and time stipulated above.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each firm may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful firm and their subconsultants will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Agreement documents and to pay prevailing wages at the location of the work. The work described in the Agreement is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

Consultant/Design Professional shall pay all persons providing services and/or any labor on site, including any University location, no less than UC Fair Wage (defined as \$15 per hour as of 10/01/2017) and shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local working condition requirements.
