UC Davis Health in Sacramento, California requests Statements of Qualifications **on or before 4 p.m. Monday, June 26, 2023**, from qualified firms interested in providing Planning services for the following project:

PROJECT NO. M058009 X STREET CORRIDOR & CIRCULATION

This project seeks to develop a study that assesses current conditions, evaluates improvement options, and makes recommendations on specific implementable projects that will improve safety and mobility on campus. The current circulation system has gaps, particularly along X Street. The study will focus on the X Street corridor and the areas feeding into X Street. This study will define future projects that will likely be implemented in phases by others. The awarded firm will be precluded from participating on teams to implement the future projects.

The University intends to select a single firm. The selected firm and its consulting team must demonstrate expertise in pedestrian and bicycle circulation programming, planning, architectural, and engineering services particularly in an academic or medical campus setting. The selected firm will be expected to sign a Professional Services Agreement. Planning work may continue through additional services such as criteria development at the University's discretion.

Statements of qualifications shall be specifically tailored to this RFQ, responding directly to the screening criteria (see RFQ document, site map, Consultant Qualification form, and sample agreement available on the above link). After Qualification Statements are received, a Screening Committee will review, conduct reference checks and recommend a short list of firms for interviews. A Selection Committee will conduct the interviews prior to selecting the successful firm.

Statements of qualifications must be submitted electronically no later than **4 p.m. Monday, June 26, 2023**, to the link to be provided by UC Davis Health. No hard copies will be accepted.

Statements of Qualifications will not be accepted after the date and time stipulated above. Firms interested in responding to this RFQ must notify the University by Friday, June 23, 2023, to be provided a link to upload their Qualifications package.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each firm may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful firm and their subconsultants will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Agreement documents and to pay prevailing wages at the location of the work. The work described in the Agreement is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

Consultant/Design Professional shall pay all persons providing services and/or any labor on site, including any University location, no less than UC Fair Wage (defined as \$15 per hour as of 10/01/2017) and shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local working condition requirements.
