Chapter 7: Donor Recognition

Overview

UC Davis Health Sciences Development and Alumni Relations Department manages all donor campaigns for all facilities, system wide. Most programs are ongoing, and therefore the donor sign program is standardized as defined in this chapter.

Larger donor recognition displays such as walls or freestanding structures are not included in this document. Please consult with Development if you expect this type of signage may impact your project coordination.

Consultant to verify the need for additional support of signs which may weigh more than 20 lbs. on a project specific basis, prior to fabrication and installation. Additional architecturally integrated and coordinated backing is required for hospital facilities per HCAI, and is recommended for consideration at all facilities.






Components

Donations at this level warrant exploration of custom design to be determined on a case-by-case basis. The drawing below should be viewed as a minimum baseline for design, but treated with premium materials at this level, if appropriate.

- (A) Letters: 1/2" thick metal letters with satin clear coat for durability and longevity
 - · Warm or cool metal may be selected to provide sufficient contrast for readability and to complement surrounding finishes; vertical grain suggested
 - Typeface: Proxima Nova Medium, 5" cap
- (B) Accent Bar: 1/2" thick painted aluminum accent bar to match width and finish of place name above
