Expressive Language: the way people express themselves to others in spoken words

Expressive Language Sampling: a way to test expressive language

BACKGROUND

- Autism prevalence is rising & a cooccurring challenge is problems with expressive language
- Language tests are used to know if a treatment works
- Most language tests are only available in English& are done in a clinical setting, creating a barrier

METHODS

- Tested if it was possible to teach parents to administer an expressive language sampling test to their autistic children using telehealth services
- Parents were trained on a Spanish or English version of the test, depending on their preference



RESULTS

- THE **MAJORITY** OF PARENTS **LEARNED TO ADMINISTER** THE PROCEDURES AS WELL AS IN THE CLINIC
- RESULTS SHOWED THAT HOME-BASED PARENT-IMPLEMENTED PROCEDURES CAN BE TAUGHT AND ADMINISTERED BY PARENTS FOR

AUTISTIC CHILDREN

IMPORTANCE& FUTURE DIRECTIONS

- These findings can be used to guide treatment
- The measures used are important for diversity and inclusion
- In the **future**, larger study samples and more parent-training to maintain the reliability would be beneficial
