

# Patient Transfer Information

## HIGH-RISK OBSTETRICS, NEONATAL AND PEDIATRIC INTENSIVE CARE

While each situation is unique, when a patient is transferred to UC Davis Medical Center or UC Davis Children's Hospital, it is usually because they require specialty care or treatments not available at the referring hospital.

UC Davis is at the leading edge of new treatments and research. You or your child's medical team has asked the physicians and nurses at UC Davis to partner with them in your family's care.

Transfer to a unit at UC Davis Medical Center will occur in one of two ways:

1. You may be transferred by ambulance, helicopter or private automobile.
2. A transport team that is highly trained in the care of infants and children may come to pick up your infant or child.

### Davis Tower 5 – NICU/SCN

Specializing in the care of high-risk infants, including those born prematurely and those needing high-risk care

### Davis Tower 7 – Pediatrics

Provides care for children with a wide range of acute illnesses from infancy to 16 years old

### Davis Tower 10 – PICU/PCICU

The only ACS verified Level I Pediatric Intensive care unit in inland CA; a new state-of-the-art facility opened in November 2011

### Davis Tower 3 – University Birthing Suites

Specialists in high-risk obstetrics accept referrals from throughout the region, providing care before, during & after delivery

### Davis Tower 3 – Women's Pavilion

Provides obstetric and medical / surgical care to a diverse female population, including mother / newborn couplet care

- **Parking Structure 3** (Long-term parking. Opens May 2012) 4251 X St.

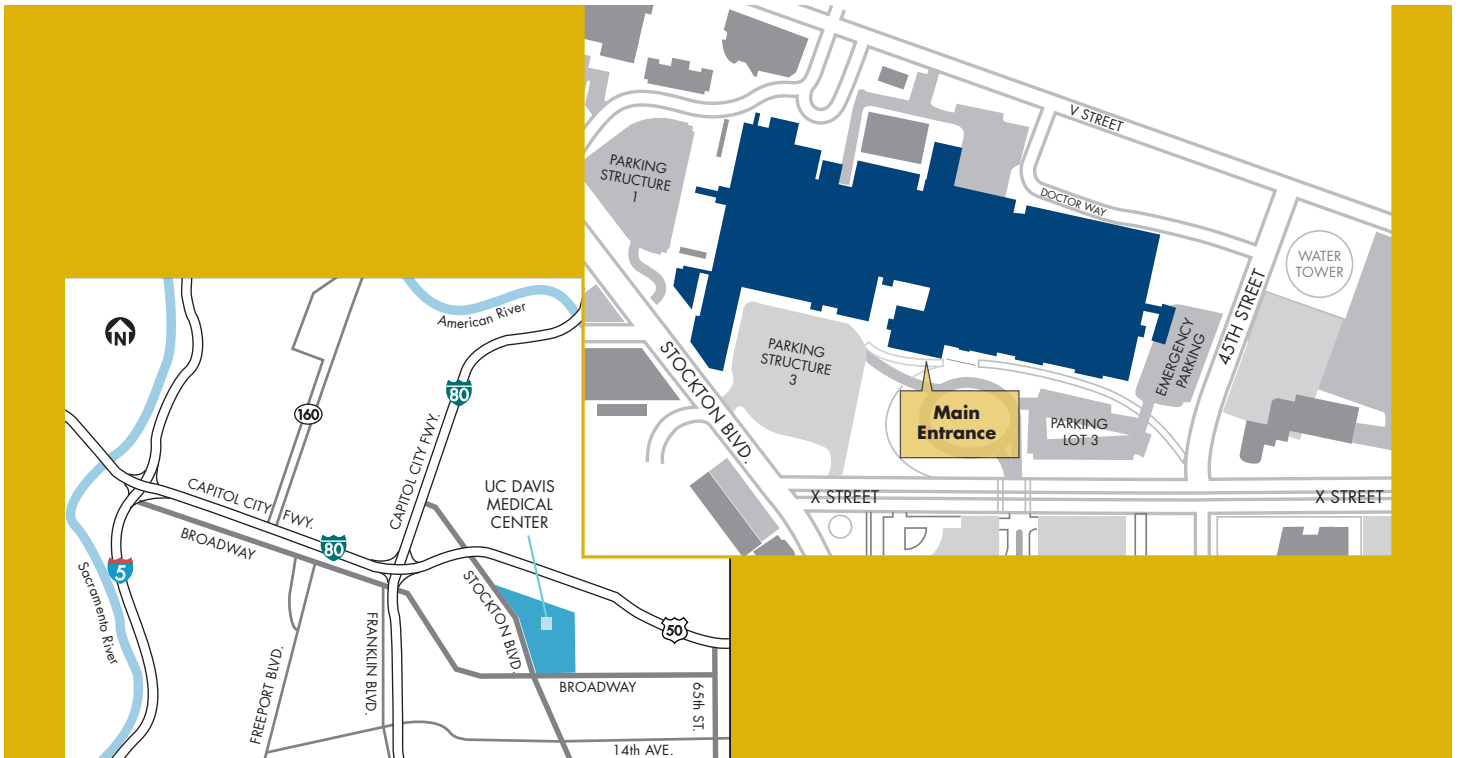

# Directions to UC Davis Medical Center and Children's Hospital



## FROM DAVIS, SAN FRANCISCO AND WEST

1. Take Business 80, East-Reno to Highway 50-Placerville.
2. Exit at 34th Street.
3. Turn left on 34th Street to T Street.
4. Turn right on T Street to Stockton Boulevard.
5. Turn right on Stockton Boulevard, and travel three blocks to UC Davis Medical Center and Children's Hospital.

## FROM PLACERVILLE AND EAST

1. Take Highway 50 to Stockton Boulevard exit.
2. Turn left on Stockton Boulevard and travel five blocks to UC Davis Medical Center and Children's Hospital.

## FROM RENO, NORTH AND EAST

1. Take Business 80 to Highway 50-Placerville.
2. Exit at 34th Street. Turn left on 34th Street to T Street.
3. Turn right on T Street to Stockton Boulevard.
4. Turn right on Stockton Boulevard, and travel three blocks to UC Davis Medical Center and Children's Hospital.

## FROM STOCKTON, LOS ANGELES AND SOUTH

1. Follow Highway 99 to Business 80-Reno
2. Exit at T Street.
3. Turn right on T Street to Stockton Boulevard.
4. Turn right on Stockton Boulevard, and travel three blocks to UC Davis Medical Center and Children's Hospital.

## FROM SACRAMENTO METRO AIRPORT AND NORTH

1. Take Interstate-5 to Business 80-Reno to Highway 50-Placerville.
2. Exit at 34th Street.
3. Turn left on 34th Street to T Street.
4. Turn right on T Street to Stockton Boulevard.
5. Turn right on Stockton Boulevard, and travel three blocks to UC Davis Medical Center and Children's Hospital.
