


A welcoming, culturally sensitive environment

Language and interpreting services

To find a physician who speaks your preferred language:

- Use the "Find a Doctor" tool online and search for your desired language in the languages field.
- You can also call the office of your choice and ask if they have physicians who speak your language and are currently accepting new patients.
- Or call our CalPERS member service line at 916-734-0702, where certified interpreters are available as needed.

Interpreting services can be provided in-person in select locations, as well as over the phone or by video conference.



Many insurance plans accepted

UC Davis Health accepts many CalPERS insurance plans. For the latest list, please visit our website at **ChooseHealth. ucdavis.edu/calpers**.

- If your health insurance plan includes UC Davis Health or UC Davis Medical Group but you are currently assigned to another medical group, your plan may allow you to switch anytime.
- If your plan does not include UC Davis Health, consider switching health plans during the CalPERS open enrollment period, the annual window for benefit changes to one that includes UC Davis Health..
- If UC Davis Health is not part of your insurance provider's network of primary care doctors and specialists, the type of insurance you have may result in additional fees to see an "out-of-network" provider. For example, if you are in a managed care plan, you may be responsible for the cost of an exam or procedure by an out-of-network physician.

Choose and start soon! Talk to your health insurance provider about your options if you would like to see a UC Davis Health primary care doctor or specialist.

Specialty care options in your community

Most of our primary care clinics also offer onsite specialty care, ranging from dermatology and OB/GYN to cardiology, diabetes care and infusion services. Services are also available at the UC Davis Medical Center campus.



Video visits

If you prefer the convenience of seeing your doctor from the comforts of home, we offer telehealth video visits for many kinds of care through the MyUCDavisHealth app and web portal.



Online tools

Our secure, confidential MyUCDavisHealth web portal and app give you the freedom to:

- Request medical appointments
- Communicate with your care team
- Join a video visit with a member of your care team for select services
- Request prescription renewals
- View your test results, and parts of your electronic health record
- Access trusted health information resources, and more.



Urgent/same-day care options

- If you develop a sudden illness or urgent health problem, your primary care clinic may be able to accommodate a request for a same- or next-day appointment.
- You can also use our online express care option, Telehealth Express Care. It's available to anyone in California for same-day and extended-hours video visits with UC Davis clinicians to discuss non-emergency issues such as flu-like symptoms, urinary tract issues, GI problems, and more.
- Your UC Davis Health provider may also assign access to a same-day, in-home urgent medical care service in collaboration with DispatchHealth.
- Based on your coverage, you can be directed by your primary care physician to an urgent care center in your insurance plan's network.



Pharmacy services

- UC Davis Health operates several outpatient pharmacies on its Sacramento campus, as well as a pharmacy at the Covell Blvd. clinic in Davis. Conveniences such as online refills, mail delivery services, curbside pickup, and immunizations are available.
- The URAC-accredited UC Davis Specialty Pharmacy provides patient education and clinical management of specialty therapies by highly trained clinical pharmacists, with home delivery available and 24/7 available pharmacist phone support. Service areas include cardiology, dermatology, endocrinology, gastroenterology, hepatology, infectious diseases, neurology, oncology, pulmonology, rheumatology and transplant.

Locations close to home

UC Davis Health primary care clinics are conveniently located in many area communities — including Auburn, Carmichael/Citrus Heights, Davis, Elk Grove, Folsom, Rancho Cordova, Rocklin, Roseville and Sacramento. Additional offices are located on the UC Davis Medical Center campus in Sacramento.



- In addition to common conditions, our board-certified dermatologists are leaders in treating even the most complex skin disorders.




Kidney disease experts

Our kidney transplant program is routinely one of the nation's largest by volume. We score at the top level for kidney failure in U.S. News procedures and conditions ratings. We are also home to a new liver transplant program.



World-class cancer care

- UC Davis Comprehensive Cancer Center is the only in inland Northern California to have earned "comprehensive" designation from the National Cancer Institute, awarded to a very small percentage of U.S. centers.
- Physicians from many different specialties collaborate to provide comprehensive care covering a broad range of cancer types.
- We provide multidisciplinary care for all stages of breast cancer. Patients receive all care in one location from a team of physicians, and have access to clinical trials.
- We also offer multidisciplinary care for all stages of prostate cancer, backed by multiple researchers and with access to a large clinical trials network.





Diabetes expertise

U.S. News ranks UC Davis Medical Center among the nation's best hospitals for diabetes & endocrinology, and is home to a high-volume kidney transplant program and a new liver transplant program.





Women's health services

- Our obstetrics & gynecology service includes many physicians ranked among the region's top doctors, and offers quality care to women in every stage of life — including contraceptive or fertility advice, routine and high-risk pregnancy care, and treatment for menopausal symptoms.
- Choosing UC Davis Health obstetrics and gynecology also means rapid access to subspecialists in high-risk obstetrics, gynecologic oncology, family planning and urogynecology.
- Ranked one of Newsweek's Best Maternity Care Hospitals for 2025, and a Baby-Friendly hospital for breastfeeding care standards.



Men's health expertise

Our urology service offers comprehensive diagnostic and treatment options for conditions such as sexual dysfunction, infertility, low testosterone, incontinence, prostate cancer, kidney stones and kidney dysfunction.



Pioneering cardiovascular care

- We rank among the nation's best hospitals in cardiology & heart surgery, and at the top level for heart arrhythmia care, heart failure care, stroke care, aortic valve surgery, transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR), and pacemaker implantation.
- UC Davis is often the first in the region to offer new diagnostic tools and therapies, such as disappearing stents, TAVR, magnetic guided catheter systems, and certain robotic heart surgeries.
- The pioneering UC Davis Women's Cardiovascular Medicine Program uniquely integrates primary and specialty health services.



Comprehensive neuroscience services

- Our neuroscience services involve multiple UC Davis specialty areas, many of which routinely rank among the nation's best.
- UC Davis physician-researchers investigate the causes and treatments of migraines and headaches to help inform clinical practice.
- Our sleep medicine laboratory evaluates disorders such as sleep apnea, restless leg syndrome, narcolepsy and sleep walking.
- Our Alzheimer's Disease Research Center is a nationally recognized center of excellence, and our clinics provide diagnostic and advanced treatment of all dementias.



Healthy aging care and services

- The Healthy Aging Clinic at UC Davis Health is an interdisciplinary clinic designed to serve adults 65 and older and their family caregivers.
- Located in our Midtown Sacramento clinic, it provides comprehensive care, including consults; cognitive care; and support services from the Family Caregiving Institute at the Betty Irene Moore School of Nursing at UC Davis.
- Specialties typically include cognitive neurology, geriatric medicine, and family caregiver services (such as assessment of stress and preparedness).

Unique fetal care and treatment center

- To help save infants at their earliest stages and give them the best opportunity for high quality of life, we founded inland Northern California's first comprehensive multidisciplinary fetal diagnosis and therapy center and performed the region's first open fetal surgery.
- The UC Davis Fetal Care and Treatment Center offers interventions in utero or in real time during the birthing process. We're proud to be one of a limited number of U.S. hospitals to offer these services.



Highly advanced neonatology services

- UC Davis Children's Hospital holds the highest-level rating for its Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) — a level IV-designated nursery — and regularly treats infants transferred from other hospitals around the region.
- Our neonatology service cares for premature and term infants with a variety of health conditions, including those who are born very prematurely, are extremely ill, or require surgery.



West Coast's first level I Children's Surgery Center


- UC Davis Children's Hospital is verified as a level I Children's Surgery Center by the world's largest organization of surgeons, the American College of Surgeons (ACS).
- The ACS program is the nation's first and only multi-specialty standards of surgical care for pediatric patients, and UC Davis Children's Hospital was the first hospital on the West Coast to earn this distinction nearly a decade ago.
- Level I centers have specialty trained children's surgeons in every discipline, with pediatric anesthesiologists and dedicated operating rooms for children available 24 hours a day.

Expertise in multiple pediatric subspecialties

- UC Davis Children's Hospital is Sacramento's only nationally ranked, comprehensive hospital for children. With board-certified physicians in more than 30 subspecialties, we can offer the highest level of care for virtually every pediatric health condition when needed.
- For example, congenital heart problems are the most common types of birth defects, affecting nearly one percent of U.S. births each year. UC Davis Health is home to a full-service pediatric heart center and provides some of the region's most sophisticated specialty and surgical expertise, with a focus on less-invasive options whenever possible.
