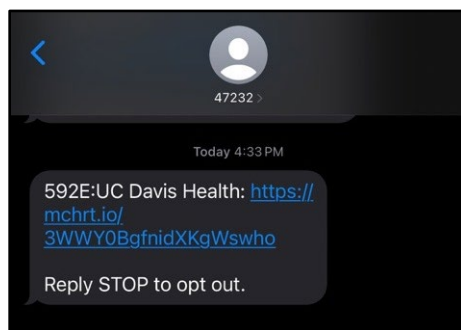


On Demand MyChart Link for Prescription Payment

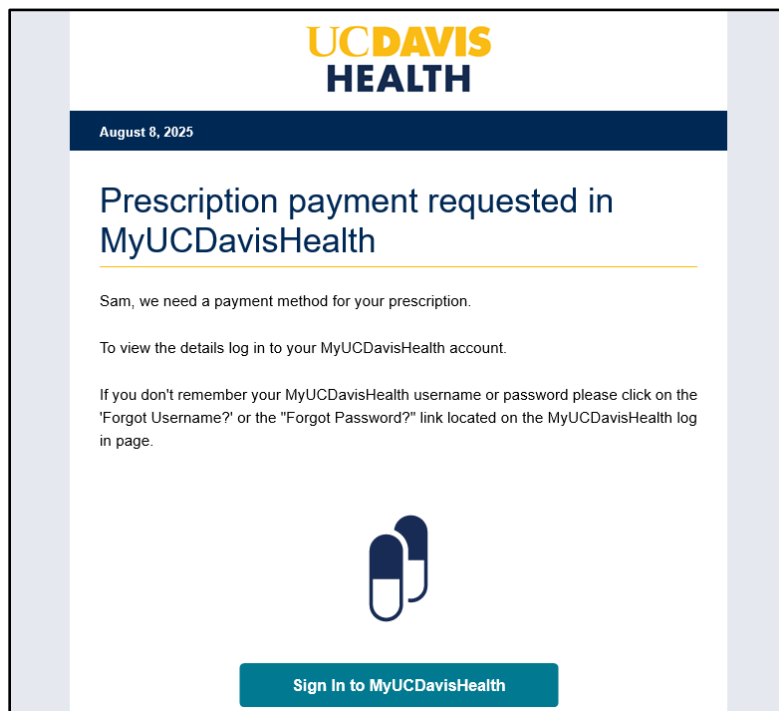
1. While on the phone with a pharmacy staff, an **On Demand Notification** will be pushed to you.

- Depending on your communication preferences enabled in Mychart, you can receive this notification by either text and/or email.

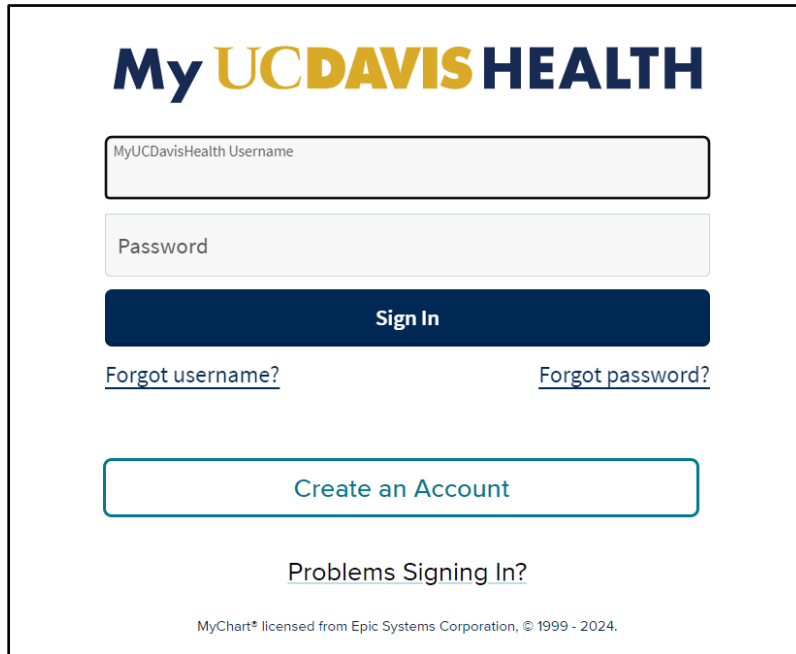
○ Example of **Text Message Notification**



○ Example of **Email Notification**

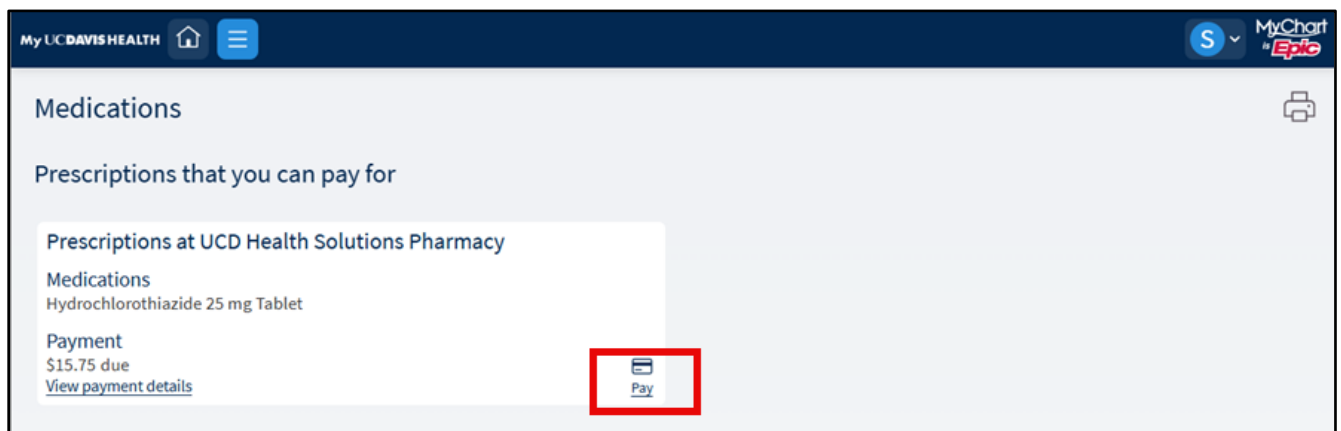


2. **Click on the link** provided and **log into** your MyUCDavisHealth account, which will take you directly to the MyChart Medication Page.
