

DONNING CHECKLIST for PAPRs

Steps	HCP
1. Dressed and ready to perform patient care <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Hair tied back ○ Jewelry, , etc. removed and pockets empty (may keep Vocera) ○ Shoes should have a back strap or heel. ○ Wear mask under PAPR hood if universal masking is in effect per current policy. 	<input type="checkbox"/>
2. Ensure all PPE available and check for integrity and correct sizing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Gloves ○ Isolation gown ○ PAPR unit (turbine, belt, headcover, breathing tube) IMPORTANT: ensure filter cover on turbine is snapped into place and secure	<input type="checkbox"/>
3. Perform hand hygiene	<input type="checkbox"/>
4. Prepare PAPR unit -refer to PAPR reference on PAPR cart for details. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure battery is fully charged • Connect battery to turbine • Check the flow of the turbine level G • Connect breathing tube to turbine • Check flow of breathing tube connected to turbine level G • Place turbine around waist – adjust to fit • Drape/dangle tubing over shoulder 	<input type="checkbox"/>
5. Don gown if needed for patient specific isolation precautions. Ensure gown does not impede air intake of the turbine.	<input type="checkbox"/>
6. Connect tubing to headcover or helmet and don headcover	<input type="checkbox"/>
8. Don gloves if needed for patient specific isolation precautions	<input type="checkbox"/>

If there are issues with the PAPR functionality, sequester the unit including turbine and battery and call central processing x42550 or “CPU charge” on Vocera.
