## IV Start Supplies

Know Where It  
Goes!

Used IV start supplies that are contaminated with and/or contain blood or other potentially infectious material (OPIM) must be disposed of in the red biohazard bin.

Biohazardous waste must be disposed of in a regulated manner, such as through high-temperature treatment, to eliminate its infectious properties, ensuring it can be safely placed in a landfill.

If you need more red biohazardous waste bins where you commonly start or remove IVs, please contact your local EH&S or EVS / Hospitality Department.
