UC Health is transitioning to an All Red-in-Red practice to simplify waste decisions for staff. Going forward, all waste with any amount and type of blood (fluid, flakeable, dried) or OPIM on it or in it will be disposed of as biohazardous waste.

Use biohazard bins and bags that you already have in your department. Contact EH&S if you need larger or smaller bins or bags, and remind your colleagues about this change too!

*Recognizable tissue is always disposed of in a Pathology waste bin.
