|  | INCOMPATIBLE HAZARDOUS WASTE CORROSIVES | <p>HD-C: Corrosives List HD-C</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hydroxyzine oral solution Chromium Chloride Zinc Sulfate |
|  | INCOMPATIBLE HAZARDOUS WASTE OXIDIZERS | <p>HD-O: Oxidizers List HD-O</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cyanide Antidote Earwax drops Used/unused Silver Nitrate Sticks |
|  | BULK CHEMOTHERAPY WASTE | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any full or partial chemo waste Disposable black containers Return to Pharmacy in areas without disposable black containers |
|  | HAZARDOUS TRACE CHEMOTHERAPY WASTE | <p>Contaminated items generated during chemotherapy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gloves Gowns Masks Empty IV bags/tubing Empty syringes with/without needles Empty vials Empty packaging |
|  | BIOHAZARDOUS WASTE | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Items with any amount of blood (dried, fluid, flakeable) or contaminated with OPIM - Policy 2005 IV Start kits (blood) Materials contaminated with excretion, exudate, and secretions from humans that are designated by Infection Prevention Committee (Refer to Policy 11025 (F)) Lab specimen bags Recognizable tissue to be disposed in a Path Waste container |
