## Disaster Preparedness

Effects of disaster and conflict on health, role of public health towards disaster-affected population, and mechanisms of humanitarian aid

Dr. Shetty received his medical degree from the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine, completed his residency in emergency medicine at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center, and completed a fellowship in Global Health and International Emergency Medicine at the University of Maryland.
