<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The California Board of Registered Nursing requires N.P.s who graduate from programs outside of California to first obtain their national board certification in order to apply for a California N.P. certificate and furnishing number. Given the board's lengthy processing time, out-of-state applicants completing an FNP or AGNP program on or after Jan. 1 must apply to AANP or ANCC by June 1, pass the nationally board exam by June 15 and submit a complete application for California licensure by July 1. There may be insufficient time for applicants completing programs outside of California in late May or early June to complete these steps by the due dates listed. Please consider your specific situation carefully before applying.
