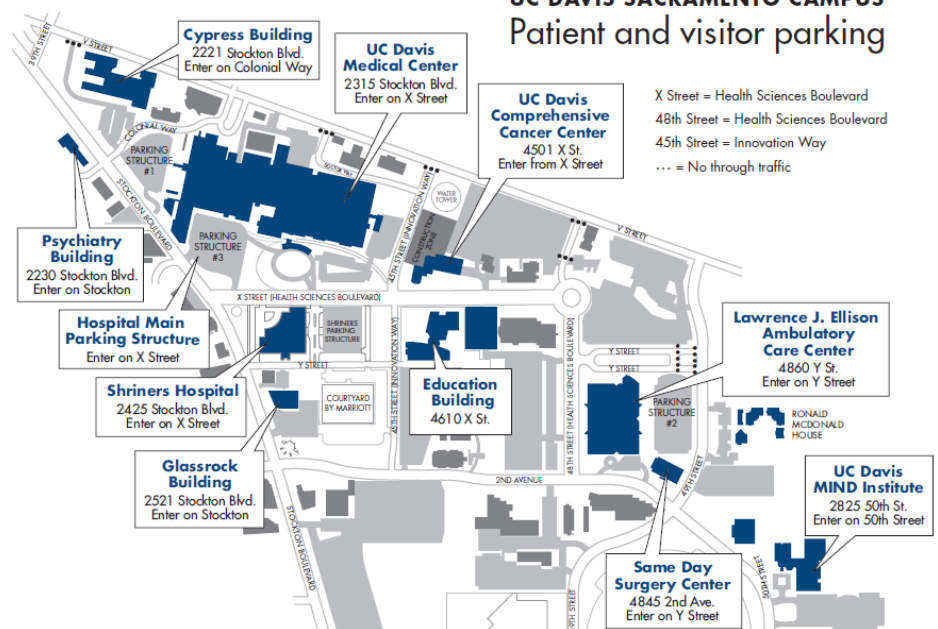

He is the Director of the UHealth Foot and Ankle Center, Chief of the Foot and Ankle service, Director of the UC Denver/Steadman Hawkins Denver Foot and Ankle Fellowship. Dr. Hunt is team physician for University of Colorado Athletics and team physician for the Denver Nuggets.
