If you are in one of these communities, you and your family or caregivers are invited to visit the Crocker Art Museum free of charge to explore the wonders of art and the creative mind. Enjoy the simple pleasures that come from discovering inspiring works of art as a trained guide leads you through facilitated group conversations. No prior art knowledge is necessary.

After the tour, you and your guests are welcome to stay and explore the Crocker on your own or simply relax in the Museum's courtyard.

Tours take place every other month on the 2nd Saturday from 11 AM – 12 PM. (First-time participants: Please arrive 15-30 minutes prior for check-in.)
