To get a sense of your personal growth, please mention briefly any important aspects of your schooling or your life, including personal circumstances, family experiences, opportunities that were not available through your school or college and your ability to prevail over challenging situations (for example: first in family to attend college? financial hardships? underserved area? contributions to underserved communities, diversity, and inclusion).

Write your personal statement in a natural style, so that it conveys who you are. Present your information and ideas in a focused, thoughtful and meaningful manner, and support your ideas with specific examples.
