There is a lot going on this month:

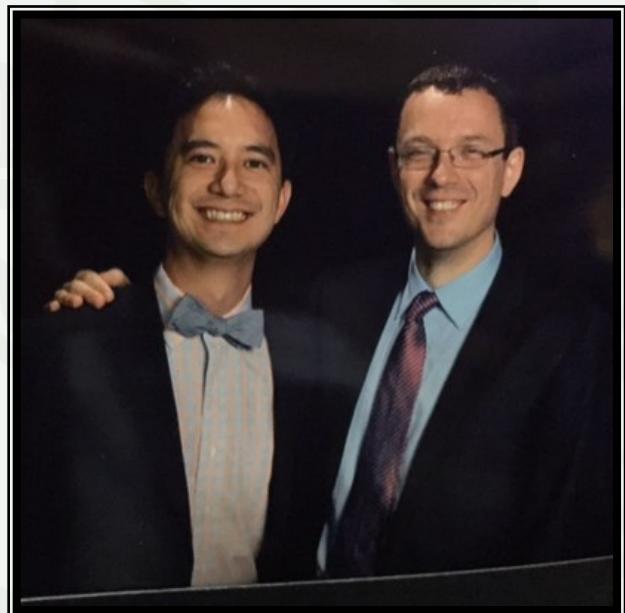
- ABSITE scores are back.
